


#### History:

This historic neighborhood is an early example of residential development in the Los Angeles Basin. Elisha P. Janes (E. P. Janes as he was known professionally) built many small tracts of English and

Spanish style "homes of distinction in scenic Altadena" between 1924 and 1926. Born in New York on July 26, 1877, Janes moved to Altadena in 1924, boasting that he would build 1,000 houses in the community. Although he fell far short of that mark, over 160 Altadena houses have been documented by Altadena Heritage as the work of Janes. In addition, there are probably several hundred more that have not been identified due to lack of building permits and other historical information.

#### Where is Janes Village?


The geographical area of Janes Village is specifically defined by the map below. While this is by no means the only place that E.P. Janes built homes, this area has the highest concentration of 'Janes Cottages' . In fact there are over 80 Janes built homes outside the 'Village' in addition to the 190-plus Janes homes in the 'Village'.
